Trisha Mann, who stars as CeCe in the film Reunion, was recently nominated for “Best Supporting Female” in the local theatre category by the NAACP for her role in If You Don’t Believe by Mike Ajakeve, in which she starred opposite Tatiyana Ali. This former Miss Black Chicago wrote and directed her first play Don’t Wait Too Late at age 15, going on to write, direct and act in plays throughout high school. Meanwhile, her successful modeling career began when Ebony and Jet magazines placed Trisha in print campaigns for Raveen and Fashion Fair products, simultaneous with her billboards and commercials for Luster Haircare.

Moving into film and television, Trisha went on to appear on Eve, The Parkers, Method and Red, and All About the Andersons. Though her performances on theatre stages soon became too numerous to list, with over 15 plays, 5 musicals and 3 operas, some highlights include An Evening of Shakespeare with Charles Dutton, David E. Talbert’s His Woman His Wife—opposite Stephanie Mills, Tommy Ford and Malik Yoba—and the NAACP award winning plays The Visit, Jeffery’s Plan and Section Eight.

Trisha is now writing and directing her own production of Mama’s Will (www.mamaswill.com) which was presented at The Stella Adler theatre and the Miracle theatre. In a word, Trisha described her time with the cast and crew of Reunion as “wonderful.”
